Once gain we have had yet another close election in Morris Township. Unfortunately, there have been two sets of election results circulating and we are not yet sure of the final results.

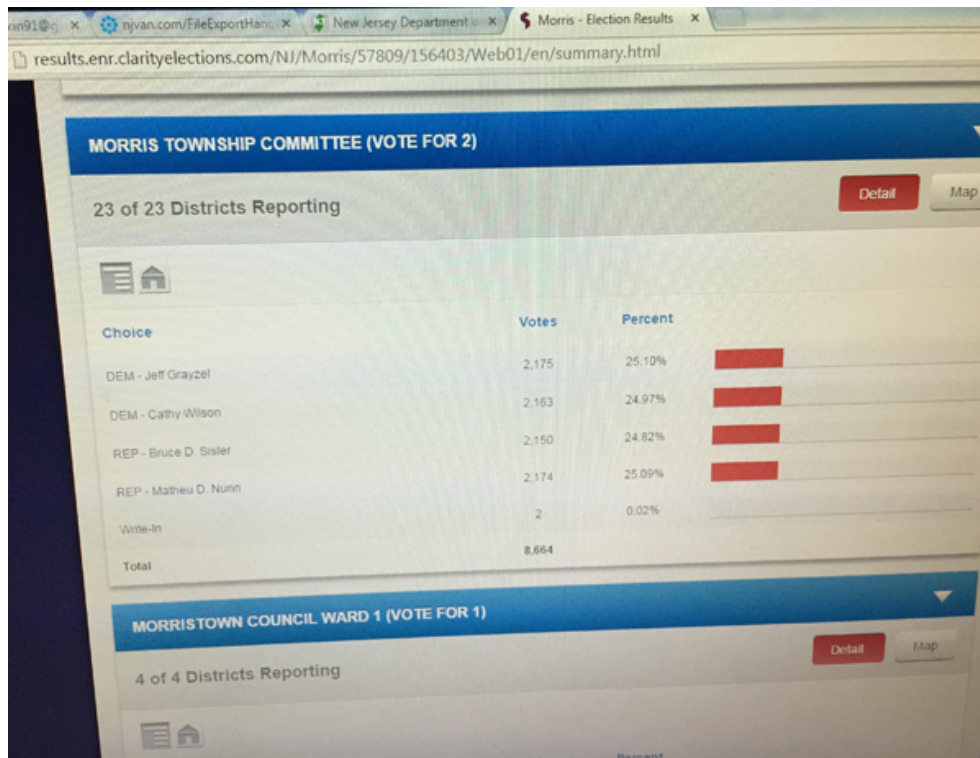
The Morris County Clerk initially published the following results on her website. These results were picked up by news organizations around the state of New Jersey.

Grayzel = 2,175  
Wilson = 2,163  
Sisler = 2,150  
Nunn = 2,174

This is a screen shot of the County Clerk's results showing all 23 districts had reported in.



About an hour and a half after that was posted, a private meeting was held in the County Clerk's office, which resulted in a change in the election results to the following:

Grayzel = 2,207  
 Wilson = 2,190  
 Sisler = 2,236  
 Nunn = 2,270

The local newspaper, the Morris Newsbee, showed yet a third set of differing results in their reported story:

Voters were segregated and made to vote at one "republican machine" and one "democratic machine." This, of course, is illegal. I am told that this went on for several hours before the County Board Of Elections intervened.

As you can see, the results are still unsettled. When I have more information I will be sure to pass it on.

I will take this opportunity to thank those who supported me and my running mate, Cathy Wilson, in our quest to bring balance back to Morris Township government. We constantly face an uphill battle in our municipality, but we are encouraged by those who have supported us.
